Legal Research and Writing is graded HP (High Pass), P (Pass), LP (Low Pass), or F (Fail). These marks do not affect the G.P.A.

Grade and credit points are assigned as follows: A+ or A = 4.0; A- = 3.7; B+ = 3.3; B = 3.0; B- = 2.7; C+ = 2.3; C = 2.0; C- = 1.7; D = 1.0; F = 0. A "C-" grade in our grading scheme reflects a failing grade and no credit. An "F" is reserved for instances of academic misconduct. At graduation, honors designation is as follows: Summa Cum Laude - top 1%; Magna Cum Laude - top 10%; Cum Laude - top 30%. For Dean's Honors each semester (top 30% of class for that semester) and overall Honors determination, grades are not rounded to the nearest hundredths as they are on this record. Marked (*) grades are Highest Grade in class; in Legal Research and Writing, marked grades (*) indicate the Scribe Award for Legal Writing.
