

# PROGRAMMATIC UPDATES

#### Backpack to Briefcase ("B2B")

The LGBTQ+ Bar launched Backpack to Briefcase ("B2B"), our new law student members-only portal to help LGBTQ+ law students navigate law school and career planning. B2B houses content that will be regularly added to and refreshed on a number of topics, including Law School Skills, Health & Wellness – including an LGBTQ+-competent provider map – LGBTQ+ Legal Knowledge, Career Planning, and more.

#### Law Student Congress Activities

The Law Student Congress ("LSC") aims to foster the advancement of LGBTQ+ law students within the framework of the Bar. 2023 highlights include:

- The LSC's Annual Meeting at our Lavender Law® Conference.
- Our Pre-Lavender Law® Q&A and Social event, planned alongside LGBTQ+ Bar staff, to help students prepare for a successful conference and career fair.
- · The Annual Virtual Drag Queen Bingo social event.

# Virtual Career Fair & Diversity Program for Small & Midsize Firms

In March 2023, the LGBTQ+ Bar held its first Virtual Career Fair & Diversity Program for Small & Midsize firms. 256 students, 22 recruiters, and 8 presenters joined for this inaugural program. The Diversity Program featured two sessions, one for students entitled, "It's Going To Be OK! Tips for How to Secure a Legal Job" and one for recruiters called, "DEI in the Legal Workplace: How to Effectively Market Your Organizational Commitment."

## PROGRAMMATIC UPDATES

#### AMICI BRIEFS AND COMMENTS

In 2023, the LGBTQ+ Bar submitted amici briefs and comments that have been used in cases concerning LGBTQ+ or other DEI-related issues. Some highlights include:

- Signing on to an amicus brief filed in 303 Creative LLC v. Elenis, explaining how anti-discrimination laws like Colorado's protect religious minorities as well as LGBTQ people and customers with other protected characteristics, such as race, sex, age, and ability;
- Signing on to a prepared statement by Why We Can't Wait reparations coalition members urging the
  Congressional Black Caucus (CBC) to prioritize reparations by 1) lobbying the White House to enact a H.R. 40
  federal reparations commission via executive order immediately and 2) passing H.R. 40 out of subcommittee and
  out of the House with a floor vote in the first 100 days of the 118th congressional session;
- Supporting a letter drafted by NCLR demanding that Congress pass the Women's Health and Protection Act in full.

# PROGRAMMATIC UPDATES

#### Resource Guide to Improve Safety in Carceral Housing for Transgender People

In August 2023, the National LGBTQ+ Bar, in partnership with Black and Pink and TGI Justice Project, launched our Resource Guide to Improve Safety in Carceral Housing for Transgender People. The purpose of this guide is to support the critical work of advocates fighting for the safety and autonomy of transgender people in the carceral system. This project is possible thanks to the ongoing assistance of our partners at Gibson Dunn; special thanks also to our partners at Lambda Legal.

Our resource guide has three components that make navigating these remedies easier:

- An interactive map that lists relevant rules and regulations by jurisdiction;
- · A downloadable sample letter designed for practitioners assisting clients;
- Links to our partners, Black and Pink and TGI Justice Project, two expert organizations dedicated to supporting transgender individuals who are incarcerated.

## PROGRAMMATIC UPDATES

#### Legislation Banning the LGBTQ+ "Panic" Defense

For nearly two decades, the National LGBTQ+ Bar has been a leader in the fight against the LGBTQ+ "panic" defense, a legal tactic wherein people accused of committing violent crimes shift blame for their alleged actions onto their victim by weaponizing their victim's actual or perceived LGBTQ+ identity.

The LGBTQ+ Bar was thrilled to educate on and support the legislation passed in New Mexico (2022) and New Hampshire and Delaware (2023).

#### The LGBTQ+ Bar's DEI Consulting Practice

In 2023, the LGBTQ+ Bar continued to grow its DEI Consulting Practice. Some highlights include:

- The Trans in BigLaw Monthly Networking Meeting, a meeting group specifically designed for trans and nonbinary attorneys working in BigLaw and led by the LGBTQ+ Bar's Director of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion, doubled in size during this time period to 24 attendees.
- The DEI Consulting Practice worked with 17 clients and conducted 57 presentations, reaching 27,000 legal professionals.





# OUT & PROUD CORPORATE COUNSEL AWARD

The Out & Proud Corporate Counsel Award is given to legal professionals who promote LGBTQ+ equality through words and actions to create more secure and welcoming workplaces. Award receptions give our legal community the opportunity to honor distinguished LGBTQ+ and straight/cisgender colleagues who have worked hard to increase LGBTQ+ diversity awareness in the corporate office and in the community.


